


Welcome to Grand Erie's eLearning!

To access the Virtual Learning Environment (VLE), go to:

Login Credentials

You will need to log in with your computer **username@granderie.ca** and your **computer password**. These are also the credentials you use to login to your Grand Erie O365 account to access email and other Microsoft programs. When you are logged into a school computer, you will not need to login when you navigate to the VLE – it will be automatically log you in. When accessing the VLE from home, you will be taken to this login screen.



Finding Your Classes

Once you have logged into the VLE, you are taken to the 'My Home' page. You will find your Grand Erie courses (both eLearning and face-to-face) in the 'My Courses' widget. You can also click the waffle at the top of the screen to access a  dropdown menu of all your active courses.

If you are taking an eLearning class with another school board, you will have access to it from the 'My Courses in Other Orgs' widget at the right of the screen.

With your mouse, hover over your course name and click it to access your class.



Navigating Your Virtual Class

You will now see the class homepage. This will be where you will see 'Announcement' or 'Activity Feed' items, class 'Updates' (unread feedback, discussions, etc.), and have access to several virtual tools like the Calendar and Office365. You will spend most of your time learning in the 'Content' area, where lessons and assignments will be posted. Your course homepage may look different, depending on how your teacher has customized it.

Check the home page for teacher office hours and information on how to start the course. Your teacher will have posted an Orientation unit to help you become familiar with the VLE.
